Adaptive Services does not serve in a "Loco Parentis" nor a caretaker role. The student must accept full responsibility for meeting applicable university standards with regard to behavior, academic performance and autonomy. If the nature or severity of the disability changes, it is the student's responsibility to notify Adaptive Services so that requested accommodations can be accurately addressed.
