France - Audencia Business School

- Also offers Fall or Spring full semester programs (earn 12 credits)

Spain - University of Barcelona

- University of Barcelona offers coursework in both colleges: Traditional Business & Resort and Hospitality Mgmt
- Tourism & Hospitality Education/Research Center offers Spring Semester program in RHM (12 credits) and 3-week Summer Programs (3 credits) for Resort & Hospitality majors as well as business majors
- University of Barcelona Traditional Business college offers Spring semester program (12 credits)

Germany - University of Wuerzburg

- 3-month Summer Program learning SAP Enterprise System with research credit earning 9 credits at FGCU

- 60 credits earned and a 3.0 FGCU GPA
- Business Major, Business Minor, Resort & Hospitality Management Major, PGM Major, or Interdisciplinary Entrepreneurship Studies Major (*Business majors must have completed all pre-reqs for full transition to major*)
- No record of an FGCU Code of Conduct violation
