FOR FACULTY... Faculty can now access a “virtual” copy of ADOBE ACROBAT PRO from anywhere on campus! This software was requested by many faculty members through the Technology Survey distributed by the Faculty Senate Tech Team last Spring. The Office of the Provost has responded to this need and has funded an ACROBAT PRO VIRTUAL LAB for FACULTY. This ‘lab’ will hold a limited number of licenses that can be shared and accessed on a first come, first served basis by any member of the faculty – full time or adjunct. You will be able to launch a copy of Acrobat Pro XI from anywhere on campus with your PC or Mac-based computer, iPad or Android tablet - and use it as if it was locally installed to... convert PDF files to editable MS Word, Excel or PowerPoint files, create new or edit existing PDF files and create ‘fillable’ PDF or web forms.
