11. Late Return of Equipment Fee (per day)	\$5.00
12. Equipment or Facilities Use, Damage or Loss	Cost

15. Returned Check Fee for Unpaid Checks as authorized by Section 832.07(1), F.S. as follows:	
a. Service charge of \$25.00, if the face value of the check is \$50.00 or less;	
b. Service charge of \$30.00, if the face value of the check is between \$50.01 and \$300.00; or	
c. Service charge of \$40.00, if the face value of the check exceeds \$300.00, or an amount of up to 5% of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.	
16. Returned Electronic Payment Fee for Unpaid ACH or other electronic payments shall be processed in the same manner as a returned check following Florida Statute 832.07(1) as follows:	Cost
a. Service charge of \$25.00, if the face value of the electronic payment is \$50.00 or less;	

- b. Service charge of \$30.00, if the face value of the electronic payment is between \$50.01 and \$300.00; or
 - c. Service charge of \$40.00, if the face value of the electronic payment exceeds \$300.00, or an amount of up to 5% of the face amount of the electronic payment, whichever is greater.
